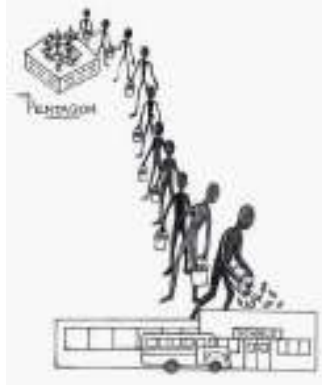

Move the Money – Stop the War Machine

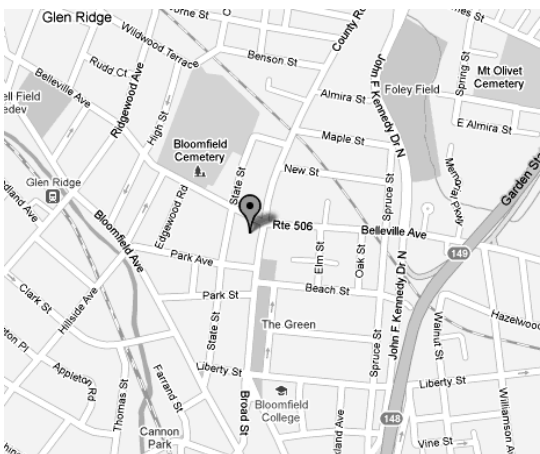

There is no military solution – we’ve heard that for years now, from the very leaders orchestrating the war, in the Pentagon, in Congress, in the White House. And yet, the military battle goes on, despite its inevitable failure.”

"We are trying to take the movement that rose in majority opposition to the war in Iraq into a new national dialogue about the impact of the war and the occupation of Afghanistan. We are operating in a new political space in which we may have great success in helping people understand that you cannot solve issues around national security with war. That the mere presence of the US military in countries such as Iraq and Afghanistan gives rise to insurgency.”

Directions to Bloomfield High School



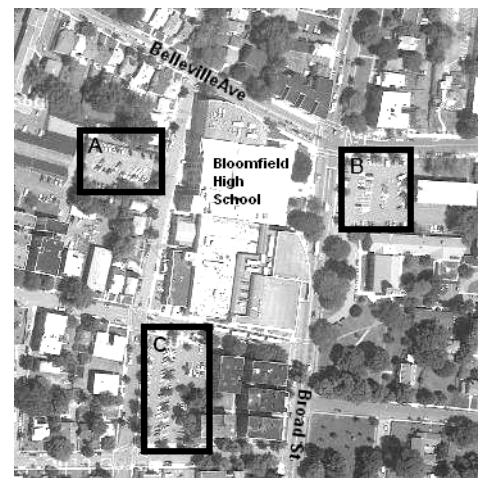
Garden State Parkway North:

Take Exit 148 - Bloomfield Avenue. Cross over Bloomfield Avenue to Franklin Street, which is the next light. Turn left on Franklin Street. Stay on Franklin Street to Broad Street. Continue on Broad Street for approximately two long blocks. Bloomfield High School is on the left side.

Garden State Parkway South:

Take Exit 149 - Bellevue Avenue. Come to the end of the ramp. Make a left on to JFK Drive. Make the first right on to

Beech Street. Take Beech Street to the end, which will intersect with Broad Street. Make a right onto Broad Street. Continue on Broad Street approximately 1 block. Bloomfield High School is on the left side.

Move the Money – Stop the War Machine!



Phyllis Bennis is a Fellow of the Institute for Policy Studies in Washington DC, where she directs the New Internationalism Project. She is also a fellow of the Transnational Institute in Amsterdam. She works on U.S. foreign policy issues, particularly regarding Afghanistan, Iraq, Iran and Palestine, as well as United Nations issues, especially regarding democratization of the UN and the challenge of U.S. domination of the UN. She serves as an informal adviser to several top UN officials on Palestine and UN empowerment issues. Phyllis Bennis has been interviewed on C-SPAN's Book TV, Democracy Now! and NPR. Her most recent book is *ENDING THE US WAR IN AFGHANISTAN: A PRIMER* (with David Wildman).



Judith LeBlanc, Field Director of Peace Action, coordinates efforts on campaigns to cut military spending, nuclear abolition and to oppose the war in Afghanistan. She works closely with Peace Action's affiliates on grassroots organizing efforts. She helps coordinate the efforts of the New Priorities Network, a national network supporting grassroots organizing to "move the money from wars and weapons to fund human needs." From 2003- 2009, she worked with United for Peace and Justice (UFPJ) coordinating national outreach efforts and served two terms as UFPJ National Co-Chair. She is a member of the Caddo Tribe of Oklahoma and lives in Harlem, NY.
