AFGHANISTAN: Please contact Rep. Pascrell and Rep. Rothman and ask them to support Rep. Barbara Lee's "Responsible End to the War in Afghanistan Act" (H.R. 780). H.R. 780 states that all funds made available for operations in Afghanistan be used only for the safe and orderly withdrawal of U.S. military personnel and DOD contractor personnel in Afghanistan.
